A.8 Date Requested for Medicaid Opening	First line on 7.01 adds: "Date Requested for Medicaid Opening" And deletes from Section A Line 8. Rationale: Allows ICAMA administrators to triage incoming forms easily and quickly.
A. all lines Child information in several sections (e.g. basis for Medicaid eligibility on Page 2)	Compiles all child-identifying information into one section at the beginning —including the basis of each child's eligibility for Medicaid. Deletes Section A, line 6. Rationale: All child information on one page.
A.1 Child's SSN	Adds: "Required to open Medicaid case" Rationale: In practice this has been left blank creating delay in provision of Medicaid
A.7 Requests date of Medicaid Closure	Date of Medicaid closure has been deleted from all sections. Rationale: unnecessary
A.2 Adoptive Parent Information	Changes to "Adoptive parent/Guardian "to include GAP cases. Rationale: Incorporates the new title IV-E Guardian Assistance Program created by Fostering Connections "Race and Ethnicity" of Adoptive parents have been deleted. Rationale: unnecessary information
A.3 Current family address	Wording is now: "Previous Address" Rationale: Original wording was not clear.
A.4 Family address in new state	Wording is now: "Address in current or new residence state" Rationale: Original wording was not clear.
B. COBRA-reciprocity policy of AA state	Removes question on "[AA} State policy on provision of Medicaid to children with state-funded AA." Rationale: Unnecessary information.
C. Other Medical Coverage	Removes "Parent private insurance information " Rationale: Removes non-federally compliant information
E. Certification	Adds: "Guardianship assistance agreement" to the wording. Rationale: Incorporates the new title IV-E GAP created by Fostering Connections
ICAMA 6.02	Changes made in ICAMA 7.02a and 7.02b and Rationale
6.02 Notifies parents that the 6.01 was sent	Form changed entirely to a cover letter (7.02a) advising parents/guardians that all necessary information has been sent to the new state and what to expect in terms of Medicaid provision in their new residence state. Includes (7.02b) useful information for adoptive parents/guardians.
ICAMA 6.03	Changes made in ICAMA 7.03 and Rationale
	"Reason for Reporting" moved to the very beginning Rationale: Allows ICAMA administrators to triage incoming forms easily and quickly.

	<p>Section D has been added— "Medicaid Extension Beyond Age 18" Designed to be used to request extension and for a response to the request. Rationale: Incorporates the new information from the Children's Bureau.</p>
