- Unifies and strengthens. Coordinates and combines messaging into a stronger, single voice for states to affect change within and across states and with federal agencies.
- Staffs and facilitates. Creates an experienced team of permanency professionals dedicated to the health and wellbeing of children and youth adopted from care.

- Informs and guides. Gives analysis and guidance on federal legislation through Policy Update meetings, materials, and AAICAMA All State Memos.
